Our Wine Policy

Although costly, great wine should be enjoyed by those who appreciate its taste and quality. Many restaurants add high mark-ups to the already costly wine, deterring some to a lesser and more affordable one. Our philosophy is to make quality wine more attractive to our customers by minimizing its mark-up. In our travels we are hesitant to order a favorite wine when we see that it is double or triple the retail value. Consequently, we have decided to maximize our mark-up to \$20 per bottle. For example, a wine costing \$50 would be only \$70 and a wine costing \$80 would be available for \$100.

Good red wines are a perfect accompaniment with steak. For the connoisseur we have some very interesting wines. Carol's favorite cabernet, Paul Hobbs Hyde Vineyard, our cost \$77 selling for only \$97.

For more moderately priced wines we have some nice Merlot, Pinot Noir, Zinfandel and Cabernets like Sebastini or Beringer.

If you would rather just have a glass of wine, we have some fine selections listed below.
